

APPLICATION
for
Aquaculture Production Class (FISH 5250/6250)
at Can Tho University, Can Tho City, Vietnam

As part of a course screening process, all undergraduate and graduate students interested in participating in this course taught in Can Tho City, Vietnam from December 27, 2017-January 9, 2018 (possibly extended a few days) must submit an application. Only selected students will be eligible to take the class. Class size will most likely be limited to 10-15 students.

Selection of AU students will be competitive and follow Auburn Abroad program requirements (www.auburn.edu/studyabroad) through the Office of International Programs (OIP). All students **MUST** meet the following criteria:

- Must be junior, senior or graduate level
- Have successfully (C or higher for UG; B or higher for G) completed FISH 5210/6210 or have instructor approval
- Be at least 19 years old and possess a valid passport by start date, and
- Undergraduates must have a minimum GPA of 2.25 or higher.
- Transient student on Faculty-led Program: 2.50 minimum GPA
- Graduate Program abroad: 3.0 minimum institutional GPA
- Have no pending judicial actions/Good standing with university
- Student under 19 years of age must complete the Minor Age Paperwork and receive approval from the Provost. All forms on the Web.
- Have a valid passport

All travel costs are the responsibility of the student. Some competitive travel grants through the College of Agriculture are available for College of Agriculture students and could provide partial coverage of travel costs (https://auburn.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_87ieA85IjZHKN5X or York ISP at <http://agriculture.auburn.edu/academics/global-programs/funding-support-for-global-engagement/york-international-scholars-program/>). Both are **due September 5, 2017**. Graduate students can apply for both but the York ISP is submitted by Dr. Daniels on behalf of the students and requires a 1-2 page CV submitted to him by **Thursday, August 31st**. However, it is the responsibility of the student to apply for grants or provide the necessary information for an application. Students are expected to share in the cost of travel.

Priority for acceptance into the class will be given to:

- Students requiring Aquaculture Production Class (FISH 5250/6250) as part of their approved Plan of Study
- Students who have completed Principles of Aquaculture (FISH 5210/6210 or equivalent) class with grade of 'B' or better. Students currently enrolled must have a 'B' or better by mid-term.

To apply, students MUST register for the course under AU study abroad https://studyabroad.auburn.edu/?go=AU_FISH_Vietnam and also register for FISH 5250/6250 in Tigeri for spring semester. In addition, students MUST submit:

- A 1-2 page CV with relevant experience
- 1 letter of recommendation, and
- A one-page essay explaining why they are interested in taking this course.
