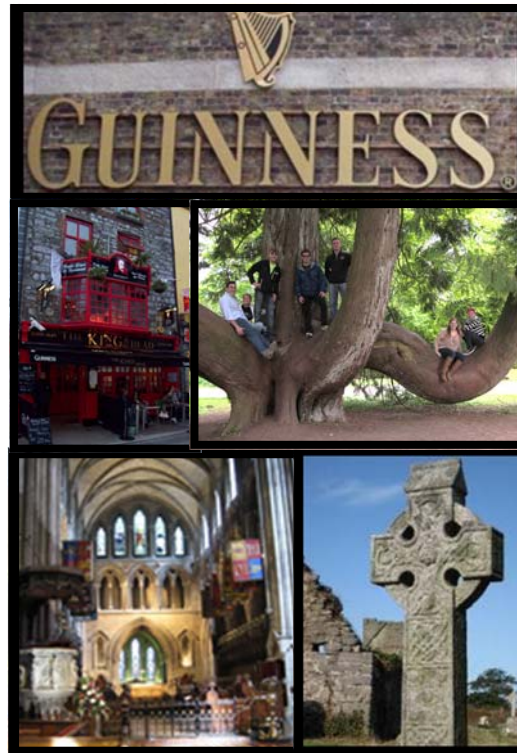

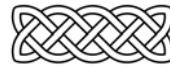

International Construction Management in Ireland



PROPOSED ITINERARY



This study abroad course will focus on the construction industry of Ireland. Students will tour new construction and historic renovation sites in the cities of Dublin, Cork, Limerick, and Galway. Students will also attend lectures/presentations by Irish faculty (Dublin Institute of Technology & the Na-

tional Institute of Ireland-Galway) and construction personnel to gain insight into the construction industry of Ireland.

Cultural visits include the Guinness Brewery, Christ Church Cathedral, kissing the Blarney Stone, Cliffs of Moher, and the Aran



Islands. Additional trips may include visits to the city of Cobh (last port of call for the ill-fated ship *Titanic*) and the lovely fishing village of Howth.

Students will earn three credit hours (BSCI elective) for this course.

The 2016 Study Abroad course is led by Professor Jenkins, who has lead the Ireland study abroad courses since 2009 and also lived in Ireland during a faculty exchange with the Dublin Institute of Technology during the Fall 2009 semester.
