# **Incoming 1:1 Exchange Student – Class Selection Guide**

### **EXPECTATIONS:**

- Each class typically meets 2-3 times a week.
- Class attendance is mandatory.
- Homework is assigned almost every day.

- You will be required to rent or purchase books for most of your classes.
