This budget is an estimate but should be close to the maximum cost. It does not include tuition for the course. As an imbedded course, there is no study abroad fee.

The highest cost is for the plane ticket and this is subject to change-up or down. I have chosen Delta because it is the most direct route with only one stop in Seoul, Korea. Other flights might be cheaper.

Food is often much less than \$20/d. If you spend this amount, you are spending a lot.

Hotel prices assume 1 person per room. There are options to share a room with one or two other students with very little increase in price.

Program Fee is charged to your bursar account prior to travel and includes a mandatory Trip Cancellation fee of 4% x airfare, visa, plus shuttle to/from Atlanta airport plus Medex Insurance (\$2/d x 15 d). Maximum reimbursement is \$1462

Immunizations are not required but you should check with your doctor for advice.

Pocket money is what you spend outside of your daily living expenses for such things as gifts, etc.
